- Finances have been fairly stable and have not changed too much from last month. We had 131,000 total last month, and we are at 130,000 this month. No significant inflows or outflows

3. Director's Report

- Since the last meeting, we had All-State Band - 4 students and 5 more right on the line.
- LGPE was last week with straight superiors for all 3 bands.
- Coming up for class placements, auditions for brass and woodwind players in the next couple of weeks
- Class setup for next year - In the fall, we will have wind ensemble first block. And in the spring, we will have wind ensemble, first block, like now. We will have our top band meet all year long in that class. The only difference is that

percussion won't be in there in the fall. Percussion will have their own separate class in the fall. Second block next year will be wind symphony. That's our second band. It'll be slightly different in the fall and the spring.

In the fall, wind symphony will be a very, very big class. And then in the spring, we're going to take that wind symphony class and split it into two other bands.

So in the fall, the four classes will go wind ensemble, wind symphony, and then we'll have our planning period, and then percussion class, the last period of the day. And then in the spring, we'll have wind ensemble first block, wind symphony, second block. And then we'll have our concert bands third.

- First time we have had a winter guard in 16 years, and it has been great!
